Directions to the Elliott Alumni Center Parking Lot:

From Route 4 West

Exit at Route 155A and turn east toward Durham. Follow 155A through a short stretch of fields to the UNH campus. After passing through the traffic light, take the next left onto Edgewood Road. One block down on your left will be the Elliott Alumni Center.

From Route 4 East

Take Route 4 East to the 155A exit.

Route 101 East

Take Route 101 to Epping; go north on Route 125 to the Lee Traffic Circle. Drive east on Route 4 to the Route 155A exit.

Directions to the Visitor's Center:

From downtown Durham/Campus Main Street (155A):

Drive past the Whittemore Center which will be on the right side of the road, pass over a bridge which spans over some railroad tracks. After the bridge, you will see a large parking lot on your right (Lot A). Turn right on to Mast Road. At the bottom of the hill is the corner of Mast Road and Gables Way. The Visitor Center is on that corner (white building with green trim).

From Route 4 West

Take the exit for Route 155A. Head east towards campus. Turn left on to Loop Road; Loop Road is located before the tennis courts on the right of the road, and green houses on the left. Follow signs for visitor parking. At the end of Loop Road, turn right on to Mast Road. The first building you pass is the Thompson School of Applied Science. The second building is the Visitor Center (white building with green trim).

Directions to Dimond Library:

If you park in the Elliott Alumni Center, walk on Edgewood Road to Main Street. Cross the street to the side where the building with the clock tower is (on your left). This building is Thompson Hall. Dimond Library, a large brick building with several large windows, is located behind this building. Special Collections, University Archives, and University Museum are located on the first floor.

If you park in the Visitor's Parking Lot, walk to Main Street and then turn left towards the center of campus. It is safer to cross the street at the traffic lights. Look for the clock tower of Thompson Hall. Dimond Library, a large brick building with several large windows, is located behind this building. Special Collections, University Archives, and University Museum are located on the first floor.
