DIRECTIONS

From I-93 south, take exit 14. At the bottom of the exit, turn right, and remain in the right lane. At the second set of lights, turn right onto *North Main Street* at the Holiday Inn. After the Holiday Inn turn right again, onto *Storrs Street*. Continue on Storrs Street; watch for a large green sign on the façade of the parking garage that spans the street. The entrance to museum parking will be the next left as you go under the garage.

From I-93 north, take exit 14. At the bottom of the exit turn left, staying in the right lane. Go straight through three sets of lights, and at the fourth set, turn right past the Holiday Inn, onto *North Main Street*. After the Holiday Inn, turn right onto *Storrs Street*. Continue on Storrs Street; watch for a large green sign on the façade of the parking garage that spans the street. The entrance to museum parking will be the next left as you go under the garage.

From the east, take I-393 to I-93 south and then follow the directions above for I-93 South.

From the west, take I-89 to the junction of I-93 north. Then follow the directions above for I-93 north.
