DIRECTIONS TO COLBY-SAWYER COLLEGE

From the South:

Take Route I-89 North, exit 11. Take a right at the end of the ramp. Turn left at the blinking yellow light at the top of the hill (approx. 1 mile). After approximately 1 mile, turn right into the Hogan Sports Center/Library Learning Center parking lot. The Archives is located in the Library (the large, gray barn and silo on your right as you enter the lot.)

From the North:

Take Route I-89 South, exit 12. Take a left at the end of the ramp. Go through New London. Colby-Sawyer will be on the left after approximately 3 miles. Take a left into the Hogan Sports Center/Library Learning Center parking lot. The Archives is located in the Library (the large, gray barn and silo on your right as you enter the lot.)
