Directions to the New Hampshire Antiquarian Society

The New Hampshire Antiquarian Society's Long Memorial Building is located at 300 Main Street in Hopkinton and is the *only red brick building* among the white colonial houses that line Hopkinton Village's Main Street. The building is set back from the street and has a white sign out in front. Parking is available on Main Street. Main Street in Hopkinton is also Routes 202, 9 & 103.

From Route 93 (traveling either North or South): get on Route 89 North (Route 89 begins in Concord). Take the Hopkinton exit (Exit 4). Keep going straight from the exit into Hopkinton Village. The Antiquarian Society will be on your right as you enter the village.

From Route 89 traveling South: take the Hopkinton exit (Exit 5). Turn right at the bottom of the exit and follow the road (Routes 202 & 9) into Hopkinton Village. Continue past The Cracker Barrel Store on your right. The Antiquarian Society will be on your left.

From Route 202/9 traveling EAST (from Henniker): be sure to take the Hopkinton exit in order to continue on Routes 202/9 so you don't end up on Route 89 South.
