The Hillsborough Historical Society houses the Manahan-Phelps-McCulloch collection, containing more than 40,000 pieces of photographic town history that capture small-town family life over a period of 14 decades. The Historical Society of Amherst, NH has made available more than 700 historic photos through its website's Digital Image Collection.
